



Steak with Pesto

& Marinated Zucchini-Green Bean Salad



To make this fast dinner come together even faster, prep the veggies and grate the cheese ahead of time, and store in an airtight container in the refrigerator.

What we send

- basil pesto ⁷
- garlic
- sirloin steaks
- zucchini
- roasted, salted almonds 15
- Parmesan ⁷
- green beans

What you need

- kosher salt & ground pepper
- olive oil
- white wine vinegar ¹⁷

Tools

- · box grater
- colander
- saucepan

Read through the whole recipe before you start. Rinse and dry all produce before using. Weights may vary slightly.

For recipes containing garlic, you'll find one head of garlic in your box.

We recommend you use coarse kosher salt stored in a container that allows you to grab it with your fingertips, or scoop with measuring spoon.

Allergens

1. Blanch green beans

Bring a medium saucepan of **salted** water to a boil. Trim ends from **green** beans, then snap in half. Transfer green beans to boiling water and cook until just tender, about 3 minutes. Drain green beans well, rinse with cold water, and drain again.



2. Prep ingredients

Peel and finely chop 1 teaspoon garlic.
Coarsely chop almonds. Coarsely grate
Parmesan on the large holes of a box
grater. Trim ends from zucchini, then cut
on an angle into ¼-inch thick ovals.
Transfer zucchini to a large bowl and
toss with 4 teaspoons oil and a pinch
each salt and pepper.



3. Prep steaks

Pat **steaks** dry, then rub all over with **4 teaspoons of the pesto**. Sprinkle steaks all over with **1 teaspoon salt** and **a few grinds pepper**.



4. Grill zucchini & steaks

Heat grill or grill pan to high and brush grates lightly with **oil**. Transfer **zucchini** and **steaks** to grill. (Save zucchini bowl for step 5.) Reduce heat to medium-high and cook until steaks are well-browned and medium-rare, and zucchini is tender, 3-4 minutes per side.



5. Assemble salad

In same bowl, combine garlic, 4 teaspoons vinegar, and a pinch each salt and pepper. Whisk in 2 tablespoons oil. Add zucchini and green beans, tossing to coat.



6. Finish & serve

Just before serving, add half each of the Parmesan and almonds to salad, stirring to combine. Thinly slice steaks and transfer to plates, spreading 1 tablespoon of the pesto on top of each steak. Garnish with remaining almonds and Parmesan. Enjoy!
